ENROLLMENT

We are approximately 2,000 undergrads from 35 states and 18 countries — and with many opinions, perspectives and points of view.

FACULTY

We are guided by **163** full-time faculty, **92%** of whom hold a Ph.D. or equivalent degree.

Mentioning our 11:1 student-to-faculty ratio is just our way of quantifying the fact that our professors know us as individuals and teach us accordingly.

FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Yes, college is expensive (though Berry is **less so** than many other selective private colleges).

We like to think of Berry as an investment, a chance to get the best possible education (and so to live the best possible version of your life).

Berry helps families manage college costs through a combination of merit scholarships, need-based financial aid grants and financing plans that spread payments throughout the year.
