Awards will be issued in the following categories:

Casual/Sportswear, Evening Wear,

Avant Garde, All Menswear (Casual/Sportswear, Evening Wear or Avant  
Garde) and Costume

Judges' choice awards will also be distributed among the age groups  
as follows:

1. 100% use of reused material (minus hidden thread, glue, tape)
2. Materials Matter - unique use of materials and integrity of  
sourcing for a true trash to treasure creation
3. Design Innovation - most original style
4. Quality Craftsmanship - how well the pieces are constructed
5. Completeness of Outfit - best use of accessories in overall  
look
6. Model Presentation - best wow factor by runway model

Minor participants, whether designers or models, must submit a signed permission slip by November 9 at 5pm. All designers under age 12 will receive a participation award.
