HON 251 Oxbridge Course (if offered)

Second Semester

Take up to 2 of the following:

ENG 102H (if not already taken)
HON 250 hybrid course
HON 251 Oxbridge Course (if offered)

COURSES IN THE SOPHOMORE YEAR:

First Semester

Complete any remaining HON 250 free elective courses to be taken (9 hrs. required for the degree)

Seriously consider the Oxbridge Lecture Course (HON 251)

Honors at Glasgow Study Abroad (either semester for gen. ed. classes)

Second Semester

COURSES IN THE JUNIOR YEAR:

First Semester

Complete any remaining elective HON 250/251 courses to be taken (9 hrs. required)

Honors at Glasgow Study Abroad (either semester for upper-level or gen. ed. classes)

Second Semester

HON 450 H (Senior Thesis I)**

First Semester

HON 451 H (Senior Thesis II)**
