

Pre-Pharmacy Requirements

While it is increasingly common for students enter pharmacy school after obtaining a Bachelor's Degree, students are still able to apply for entrance to Pharmacy School after completing only two years of college. Students seeking to enter pharmacy school after two years at Berry College must take the courses listed below. There is no room for electives, four very full semesters are necessary to complete the prerequisites, and substitutions are not permitted. All schools also require an acceptable score on the Pharmacy College Aptitude Test (PCAT). While Berry students have been admitted to a variety of schools, the requirements for Mercer and UGA are listed since they are the most common schools students ask about. Students with specific questions about these Pre-Pharmacy requirements or entrance to pharmacy school should consult with Dr. Andrew Bressette in the Chemistry Department.
