South Rome Early Learning Center 2022 Report Card

The full Georgia Early Learning and Development Standards (GELDS) curriculum continues to be implemented in both classrooms with a continued focus on emergent literacy and language acquisition.

The Center maintains the Three-Star Quality Rating by Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning—the highest indicator of quality preschool programs in the State of Georgia!

A formal assessment of the children's progress is conducted twice each year. These assessments show consistent progress in meeting GELDS benchmarks in communication, language, and literacy (early reading).

Our first class from 2015 is now enrolled in Fifth Grade and we are tracking their progress. They are outperforming their peers!

All parents and guardians attend Parent Engagement Meetings, building community and learning parenting skills. We are partnering with restoration Rome to provide these meetings.

Parent/Teacher Conferences are held twice a year, giving teachers and parents dedicated one-on-one time to discuss their child's progress.

Funding from the STABLE grant will provide \$87,354.00 over two years.

The Georgia GOAL Scholarship Program raised \$118,256.48 to support tuition.

We continue to have a very low teacher/student ratio, providing individualized attention to each student. The majority of our students are from the South Rome Community.

Berry College student workers serve as extra support in our classrooms.
