

## **Housing Information at University of Glasgow**

### **Closest to Campus:**

- Student Apartments (Hillhead and Gibson Street) - also the cheapest option. Flats house 20 or so students, sharing rooms and bathroom/kitchen facilities. The apartments are in Victorian style tenement blocks.

### **10 min. walk from Campus:**

- Cairncross House - (mostly freshers students). Mostly shared rooms and typically dorm-style. Shared bathroom/kitchen facilities.
- Kelvinhaugh Gate - (mostly upper year students) - Single study bedrooms in flats of approx 6 people. All with ensuite shower/toilets. Shared kitchen. One of the most expensive residences.
- Kelvinhaugh Street - (mostly upper year and pg students) single study bedrooms in flats of approx 6 people, shared kitchen/bathroom facilities.

### **20 min. walk from Campus (through Botanic Gardens):**

- Queen Margaret Hall - mixture of freshers through to upper year students. Single study bedrooms in flats - all with ensuite shower/toilet. Shared kitchen facilities within each flat. One of the most expensive residences.
- Winton Drive Flats - mostly upper year/pg students. Single study bedrooms, shared kitchen/bathrooms.

### **20-30 min. walk from Campus:**

- Murano Street Student Village - flats/hostels. Flats are shared by approx. 5-6 students; hostels up to 12. All single study bedrooms with shared bathroom/kitchen facilities. Largest residence - houses approx. 1,000 students.

### **Approx. 3 miles from Campus (not really walkable - public transport is required):**

- Wolfson Hall - which is the only catered hall. Mix of all levels of students and many vet students live here. Wolfson is the most expensive residence

because it provides meals. Mostly single study bedrooms, some with ensuite bathroom facilities.
