

## Cage Center Building Use Policies

### **Policies and Procedures (Students, Faculty & Staff)**

- You must have a current Berry College ID card to enter the fitness center.
- All patrons are responsible for their own welfare in the Cage Center. Berry College does not assume the responsibility for any injury occurring during recreational activities. Please consult a physician or healthcare professional prior to beginning any workout regimen or physical activity.
- The Cage Center is available to all Berry students as well as faculty, staff, spouses, and their dependent children (defined as children that are under the age of 26 and are living under their parent's roof) at a complimentary (no charge) basis.
- Part-time students are able to purchase a membership during the semesters they are enrolled on a part-time basis.
- Students, faculty, and staff are allowed to check in guests a total of 10 times per year provided:
  - You must be in attendance with your guest.
  - Guest must sign a liability waiver.
- Tracking of guest passes will be kept at the Cage Center front desk and will reset on June 1<sup>st</sup> of every calendar year.
- Facilities that are available to Cage Center patrons include the following:
  - Fitness Center
  - Indoor walking track
  - Two multi-purpose rooms
  - Natatorium
  - Racquetball courts
- The Facilities may be used anytime the Cage Center is open and available, depending on scheduling. See check-in desk for details. During non-reserved times, these recreational facilities work on a first-come first-served basis.
- Cage Center facilities may be reserved for a group function depending upon availability. Contact Assistant Athletic Director, Derek Taylor at [dataylor@berry.edu](mailto:dataylor@berry.edu) or 706-238-7798 for more details.
- Appropriate attire is required for all facilities:
  - Bathing suits only (no T-shirts) in the pool.
  - No black-soled or marking shoes on any court, multipurpose room or the indoor track.
  - Shirt and athletic shoes required in fitness facility.
- Please return all equipment to check-in desk or the appropriate area.
- Please report all injuries or emergencies to the check-in desk.
- Please do not leave valuables unattended.
- Lockers are available based upon availability. Please contact Derek Taylor for more details.
- With the exception of service animals, no pets are allowed in the Cage Center.
- The use of Cage Center facilities outside normal operating hours is prohibited.

### **Policies and Procedures (Community and Alumni)**

- All policies and procedures for community and alumni members are the same with the exception that community and alumni members are not permitted to check-in guests.
