Blog Setup:

Click the Setup link to go to the setup page.



You can enable students to subscribe to the course blog in their personal RSS reader.

RSS Subscription

This portlet is able to create an RSS feed of the items you post, to which users can subscribe via their news r enabling this feature means all your posts must be public, so you will not be able to manage security on a pos

RSS: Enable RSS (also disabling post-level security)

You can enable comments (you will have to select another option further down the screen also).

You can also include your name as the author and designate who can view the blog.

Default Values

The values you select here will be used as the defaults when you add a new post to the portlet.

Item List

This determines how the posts will be displayed on the Main screen.

Full Item

This section is where you give permissions to students and faculty to comment. Only students and faculty enrolled in or teaching the course will have the ability to comment and post, not all students and faculty at the institution.

Note: If you enable comments after writing a post, students will not be able to comment on that post, but will be able to comment on subsequent posts.



Blog Portlet

Below is an example of the blog portlet once you have posted a few entries.



- The blue side bar indicates the most recent blog post.
- The Discuss link shows you how many comments there are for each post.
- The title of the second entry (Second Example Blog Post) is in red because it was listed as having high priority.
- The Read more link will open the full post
- The Subscribe link will allow students to subscribe to the blog.

If you click on the Discuss link, you will have an area to type in a comment and Save a comment.
