SKILLS

Interpersonal : Motivated students into giving their best at learning the language and keeping them engaged beyond time spent in the classroom in groups of 5 to 30, in a F2F and remote format.

Organizational : Took charge of my continuing ed during the outbreak of Covid-19 and attended webinars offered by textbook publisher VHL to organize my classes for the transition to remote teaching. Prepared courses independently, researched extra material and delivered it all according to the time-line set in the syllabus for three four-credit hour courses per semester. Organized two culture-specific parties per semester per class with songs, games, group dance, all performed in the target language. Organized twice, as an alternative, a "crêpes" cooking class which required locating accessible kitchen area, buying food items, bringing in kitchen tools, coaching students with food preparation, making time for food enjoyment and clean up.

Creative : In a remote format I developed numerous exercises on the VHL platform with music videos appealing to students, upon which they engage remotely in the target language with a partner in a Partner Chat recorded activity to which I offer feedback. In F2F classes I tried out new ideas in class, as for ex. working with play-dough when learning the names of furniture and disposing it in rooms set out on paper - to which students responded unanimously with surprise, laughter and a high degree of interest.

Technical : Transitioned three four credit courses in two different languages to a remote teaching format during the Covid-19 outbreak. Have learned to teach via Zoom and the Vista Higher Learning online platform, give and proctor simultaneously online tests, and adapt to new technical requirements to ensure an engaging and effective digital learning environment for all. I adapted newly learned IT skills to the courses so that the students may keep engaged with the language beyond the time spent in class (integrating Youtube on GaView Vista, presenting effective and interactive powerpoints, creating discussion boards, learning D2L and VikingWeb)
