## **ACTIVE LISTENING AND READING**

When you think of reading or listening to a lecture, you probably picture yourself looking like this:



## When Reading:

- Annotate: Take notes in the margins of your book as you read
-Make study sheets as you go and record any questions about the text
-Read and/or ask questions aloud
-Stop at intervals to summarize what you've just read
-Pre-Read, then work to create a chapter outline as you go

## When Listening:

-Take notes, even if you may not refer back to them; it will keep you focused

-Use a different color pen for each topic addressed -Sit at the front of the class and make eye contact with your professor

-If you have trouble focusing, bring a stress ball or some play dough
