How do I get a job?

Your first job will be assigned to you by the LifeWorks Program based on your previous experience, interests, and campus needs. After your first semester, you may choose to remain at your current job or seek new employment on campus. Available jobs are posted on the student work website.

How many hours can I work?

All students can work up to 12 hours per week, but new students

are limited to 10 hours a week for their first year as they transition to the campus life and academic rigor at Berry.

How much will I be paid and when?

Student workers start off making \$9.25 an hour, and as your responsibilities increase, so will your pay. Paychecks are sent to student boxes every two weeks. Direct deposit is available through the payroll office.
