There are 85.5 miles of paddling trails in Floyd County. The table below provides a short list of local access points.

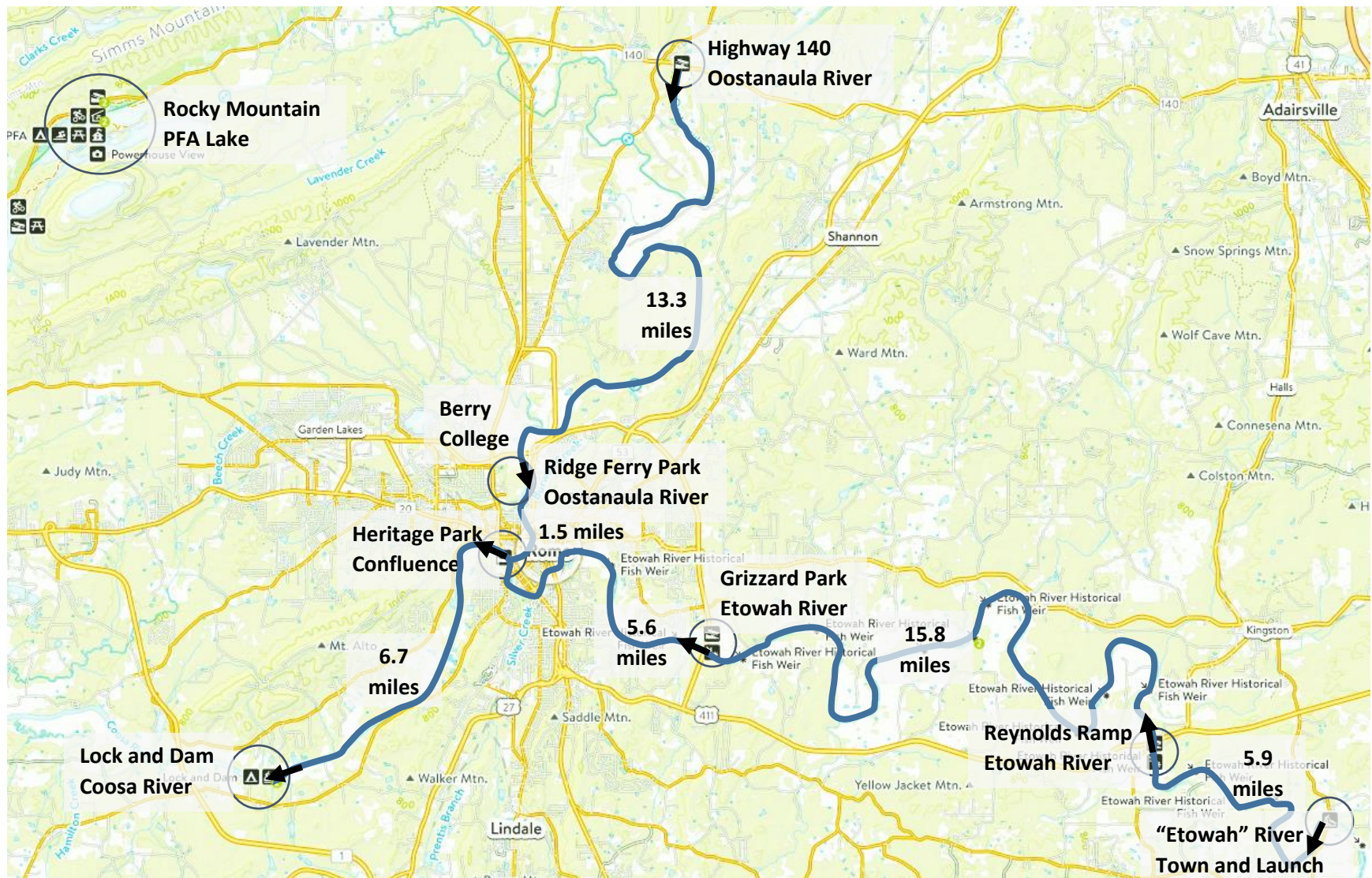
