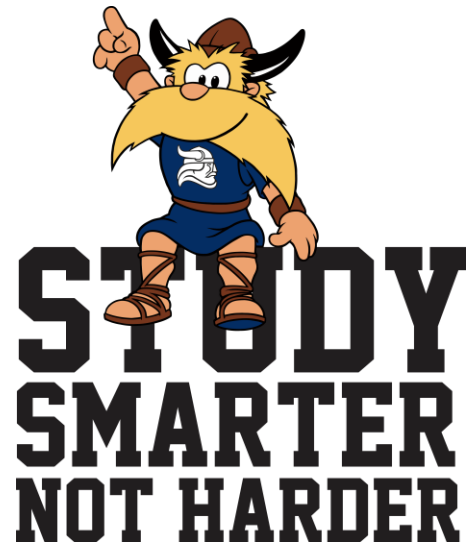
ASC Sessions

- Your student says, "I have **NO** idea how to do my problem set for Statistics!"
- You can say, "Why don't you check and see if the Commons offers Statistics ASC Sessions this week?! You can work with other students in your class and a trained peer tutor."



Individual Academic Consultations (IACs)

- Your student says, "I studied for that test. I don't understand why I received the grade I did."
- You can say, "I know you tried your best. Maybe you should schedule a consultation and make a new game plan for upcoming tests."



Writing Center

- Your student says, "I need someone to read over my paper, but I don't have time to go to the Writing Center."



- You can say, "Actually, there are three ways you can meet with a writing consultant: you can make an appointment, drop in, or just submit your paper and receive feedback within 24 to 48 hours!"
