General description of activity abroad:

I have published on an eighteenth-century Peruvian writer (Pedro Peralta Barnuevo), but I have never been to Peru. I am interested in going to establish some relationships/contacts at several libraries and archives for the purpose of future research. Specifically, I would like to take a group of 2-4 Berry students to Peru to work as a research team in these archives and libraries. This would take place in 2013, possibly in 2014. A colleague of mine from Mary Washington University led a similar research project in Spain with undergraduate students and had great success.

In addition to the libraries and archives listed below, I plan to visit several other historical sites in Lima and to make a trip to Machu Picchu, near Cuzco. I have taught about these places for more than a decade now, but have yet to experience them in person.

Visiting the following libraries and archives would give me a good idea of the most fruitful sites for work with students the following summer. We likely would not be able to do meaningful work in all of these places; therefore, the visit in 2012 would help me make good decisions for the next summer. Sites include the National Library (Lima), the National Archive (Lima), the Archive of the Archbishopric of Lima, the Riva-Agüero Historial Archive (Lima), the Lima Metropolitan Archive (church), the Regional Archive of Cuzco, and the Bartolomé de las Casas Center for Andean Studies in Cuzco.

While I have not settled on the topic of study, I am interested in investigating how legal cases against "heretics" actually represented more complex ways of routing out unwanted cultural presence in 18th-century Peru. For example, someone might be accused of "Lutheranism" but the actual case against the person might focus on questions of identity and action that go far beyond someone's religious practices. Perhaps it was a way of exercising legal action against foreigners or troublemakers.

Here are links to the places I have been researching up to now. In 2009 I co-edited a book with Prof. Jerry Williams, who has very close connections with librarians and archivists in Lima. I plan on requesting his assistance as I prepare for the visit.

Describe anticipated professional and personal outcomes of the experience. How will your activity contribute to the internationalization of Berry College?


Even without the plans to take students for the research project, having firsthand knowledge of Lima, Cuzco and Machu Picchu would be of immense value to my understanding of these places. I frequently teach about them in my Latin American culture courses and other Spanish courses.

Taking students the following summer would clearly contribute to internationalization at Berry. It would engage students on a very deep level and would give them the rare opportunity to collaborate in real research in this field, something very difficult to do from within the bubble.

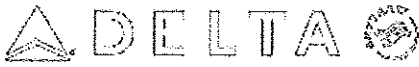
