Students are required to complete 72 Murdoch credit points to graduate with a “normal” 3-year undergraduate degree (i.e. 24 credit points per year or 12 credit points per semester).

The maximum semester point load for Study Abroad students at Murdoch University is 12 points per semester.

Recommended credit:

3 Murdoch credit points = 4 US semester hours/credits

4 Murdoch credit points = 5 US semester hours/credits
