- ◆ *The average length at the University of Otago for undergraduate degrees is 3 - 4 years, depending on the degree. A typical full-time load is usually 72 points, consisting of 4 individual subjects (papers).*
- ◆ *Students must enroll in a minimum of 54 points. It is not recommended for students to enroll in more than 90 points.*
- ◆ **An aegrotat pass is a special consideration where the examiner certifies that the candidate's performance and competence in the paper (class) were well above the minimum standard required to pass the paper.*

Recommended credit:

18 points at the University of Otago = 3 - 4 US semester credits

This grading conversion advice provided is subject to change should the university revise their credit system.
