The Georgia Performance Standards for economics at grades 6 and 7 focus on three basic concepts: types of economic systems; economic growth and development; and international trade. Because global neighbors have become increasingly interdependent, it is commonplace to hear about international trade, trade restrictions, and how weak or strong the dollar is relative to other currencies.
