

# Committee Constitution

## Committee Membership:

- WAC Committee members are elected by the Faculty and Student Government
  - Two faculty from the School of Education and Human Sciences
  - Two faculty from the Evans School of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences
  - Two faculty from the School of Mathematical and Natural Sciences
  - Two faculty from the Campbell School of Business
  - One faculty from the Faculty Assembly
  - One student from the Student Government
- Faculty members from each school will serve two year terms, with alternating termination dates to assure the continuity of school representation.
- The Provost is an *ex officio* member representing Berry College leaders.
- The Director of Center for Teaching Excellence is an *ex officio* member.

## Program Structure:

- The WAC Committee will be organized into five subcommittees, as follows:
  1. **Leadership**- Chair, Provost, CTE Director
  2. **Operations & records**- two members from different schools
  3. **Marketing & Awards**-two members from different schools, plus a Student Government representative
  4. **Evaluation & Research**-two members from different schools
  5. **Speakers & Workshops**-two members from different schools
- The Provost (ex officio member) provides resource support, as appropriate
- The Director of Center for Teaching Excellence (ex officio member) coordinates CTE & WAC Program initiatives.
