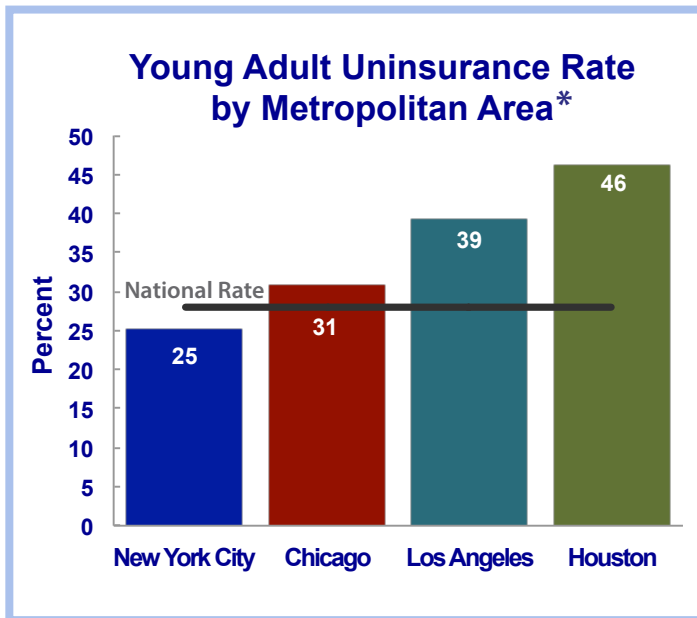
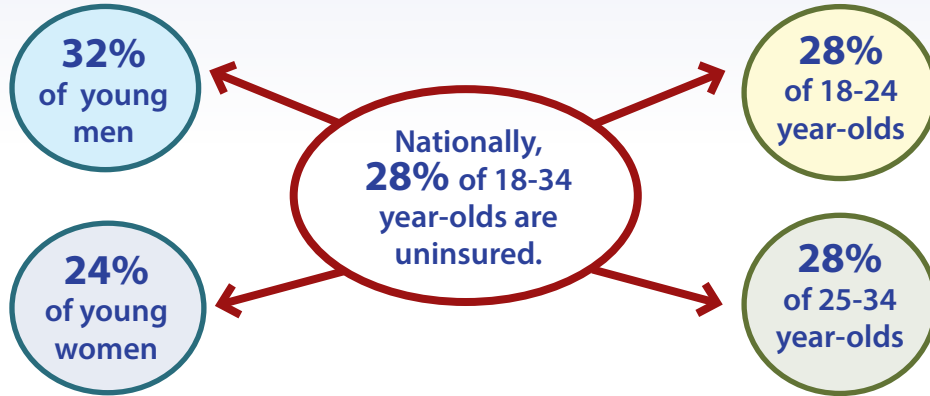




# Who Needs Health Care Coverage in the USA?

## HEALTH CARE OPTIONS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

- » Young people will have the option to buy a plan through their state's health insurance marketplace. For more help getting covered, check out [healthcare.gov](http://healthcare.gov).
- » Nationally, up to 9 million currently uninsured 18-34 year-olds could be eligible for new tax credits at the health insurance marketplace.
- » If all states implemented the ACA's Medicaid expansion, up to 7.8 million currently uninsured 18-34 year-olds nationwide could be eligible for Medicaid in 2014.
